

SAI-U® Oily Waste Can User Manual

Function Of Oily Waste Can

- It is used to collect waste such as wipes and paper soaked with flammable adhesives, oil and other flammable liquids.
- The danger of spontaneous combustion can be effectively eliminated by isolating waste from the fire source and limiting the amount of oxygen.

1. Installation and Placement

- The device is fully assembled and can be used directly.
- Foot operated switch control, the maximum angle for opening the bucket lid can reach 60 degrees.
- Can be placed in laboratories, offices, workshops, warehouses, and other places.
- Oily waste can should be placed in well ventilated areas away from sources of fire and flammable materials. Avoid direct sunlight and humid environments.

2. Cleaning And Maintenance

- Regularly clean the oily waste can and remove the garbage and debris inside the bin.
- When cleaning, a damp cloth or neutral cleaning agent should be used to wipe the barrel body, avoiding the use of corrosive cleaning agents such as strong acids and alkalis.
- Check the sealing and fire resistance of the oily waste can, and replace it promptly if it is damaged.
- Oily waste can must be emptied every night and clearly marked for emptying.
- Please use the handle and bottom of the oily waste can when moving, transporting, and emptying it.

3. Notes

- Oily waste can must be placed on the floor, let its lid is free to open and close.
- It must be kept closed at all times, except for discarding waste or emptying trash cans.
- Burning items in oily waste can is strictly prohibited.
- Do not put unextinguished cigarette butts, matches, etc. into fireproof garbage cans.
- If abnormal conditions such as odor or smoke are found in the trash can, stop using it immediately and take corresponding fire extinguishing measures.
- Follow local fire safety regulations and use oily waste can correctly.
